






## Working for Each Other with Diversity to Build a Future Community

### I Connecting to People

#### Main Initiative

- We will create an easy-to-understand website to provide information to foreign residents.
- We offer Japanese language classes and Japanese language training for foreign technical interns.
- · We will create a service where foreign residents can consult.
- We will distribute brochures to promote membership in the Jichi-Ku and inform people of the role of the Jichi-Ku through "Easy-to-understand Japanese"
- We will create opportunities to learn about the situation of foreign citizens through events.

### II Connecting to the Communities

By connecting with local communities, related organizations, companies, schools, etc., we will lead foreign residents to a secure life in the community.

#### Main Initiatives

- We will visit companies to gather information on foreign employees and identify key people.
- Foreign residents can participate in events held by the Local Community Development Council and interact with the local community.
- · We will support the participation of parents of foreign students in PTA activities.
- We will strive to disseminate disaster information in multiple languages.
- We will encourage foreign residents to participate in disaster prevention drills and training sessions.

#### Main Initiatives

- In cooperation with "Niji no Kakehashi", we will provide guidance on Japanese language and school life.

- Japanese students will learn about different cultures and learn about multiculturalism through foreign language activities and English classes.
- Foreign residents use social networking services to communicate the charm of Kakegawa City's lifestyle and tourism to the world.
