

#### **Basic Rules for Refuse Collection**

- Refuse collection sites are determined by area residents. If you do not know the site location, please ask your apartment building manager, someone at your office, or a neighbor.
- Bring your refuse to the collection site only on collection days, and before 8 a.m. Do not bring it the day before or before dawn.
- Put combustible refuse in the refuse bag designated by Kakegawa City. Designated bags are available at general stores, supermarkets, convenience stores, and other stores.
- The monthly collection site is in a different location than the weekly collection site. Please confirm the location of both sites.




Place combustible refuse into the designated semi-transparent polyethylene bag for collection.




